In the Spirit of the New Year, as we all consider positive changes in our lives and in conjunction with the spirit of Doug's message last week concerning new ways to live and serve Jesus, I offer 16 Outreach Opportunities for 2016. These are by no means all of the opportunities before us but they are a good start at the start of this New Year. They all include all of us to one degree or another.

1. Mission trip to Guam and Saipan January 13-25. You are already supporting this trip financially by paying my wages while I am there and I ask for your prayers as well. My travel expenses are supplied by individuals and do not come from church funds.
