We have already shared some information about our Prison Ministry and our Visitation Ministry. Last week I shared a little about our "marriage enrichment ministry" by reviewing the PREP facilitator training I had attended in Denver. If you missed these articles and want to know more about them, please see me. One reason we share information about our ministries is to encourage you and also to ask for your prayers. <u>Another reason is to ask for your involvement in these various ministries.</u></p> <p>The ministry I would like to tell you about this week is our "Quilting Ministry." During a visit with Della Fiske-Turner several years ago in her home I found out that she was a quilter. I asked her if she might be interested in helping us as a church to develop a "quilting ministry". Of course Della was willing and several ladies met in February of 2004. They actually began quilting at the end of March, 2004. They meet on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month and have from 4 to 15 ladies in attendance. Many of the ladies are not members of our congregation but are faithful in their service to this ministry.</p> <p>Since March of 2004, 533 quilts have been distributed throughout the world. Quilts have been sent to Russia, India, Honduras, Nicaragua, Katrina victims, Joplin, Missouri tornado victims, The Dell House in Colorado Springs, St. Mary's Hospital, Community Hospital, Mt. States Children's home, and to forest fire victims in Colorado Springs and Fort Collins. Many in our congregation have received quilts as well. Quilts are often given to members with serious health issues, those needing some extra encouragement and those with newborns.</p> <p>This quilting ministry is a great work of love, compassion and service which has in the past and continues in the present to share God's love with people in need. <u>This ministry can always use more volunteers. You do not need to know how to quilt. Free instructions will be lovingly given.</u> Please see Della Fiske/Turner for more information or to volunteer.
