Memory Verse For May: Col. 1:15

"By Jesus all things were created...visible and invisible"

How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!
It is like precious oil poured on the head, running down on the beard,
running down on Aaron's beard, down on the collar of his robe.
It is as if the dew of Hermon were falling on Mount Zion.
For there the LORD bestows his blessing, even life forevermore.

God designed the church to be a place of unity and harmony and relational connection. As Psalm 133 says, it is good when brothers and sisters experience harmony. One of the best ways to create and maintain healthy relationships is through accountability with another follower of Jesus.

David wrote this psalm, which talks about how wonderful it is for people to live in unity. He wrote those words thousands of years ago, but the principle remains true today: Harmony in the body of Christ is important. In John 13:35, Jesus said people would recognize his disciples because of their love for each other. Our sacrificial love for others can become evidence to our culture that Jesus is real and able to change lives. It's an important step in helping teenagers take ownership of their personal faith.

David uses some descriptions in Psalm 133 that sound foreign to a 21st-century audience. For example, he talks about the ordination ceremony for Moses' brother Aaron. The ceremony included Moses pouring anointing oil onto Aaron's head, which symbolized God's blessing. People near Aaron at that ceremony would have experienced the beautiful aroma of the anointing oil. In the same way, harmony among believers creates a beautiful aroma that blesses others, including nonbelievers.

Creating harmony requires real work to get along and live together in peace. We don't always agree and we don't always get our way. Deep friendships can be formed when two people decide they will hold each other accountable so they can both grow spiritually. A true friend welcomes constructive criticism and wants to understand your point of view. Friends who are accountable to each other work together. Each wants what is best for the other—God's plan and purposes for life.
