It is wonderful to be back after an almost two week mission trip to Guam. Thank you for your interest in and support of this work. God blessed me in so many ways and I am grateful to Him and to you for the opportunity to help this small congregation.

As a result of my first Sunday morning's Bible class one lady was moved to organize a Saturday night community outreach effort at the place I stayed in Mangilao. On Friday I passed out around 100 invitations to the apartment buildings across the street. One individual came as a result but we had four other visitors from an invitation a church member had given at a place of business he deals with. Also, a neighbor came as a result of one of the church members going over right before we started and asking him to attend. This neighbor was originally from Pohnpei and had been a student at the University of Guam when I was campus minister there from 1974 to 1976.

The evening went well and we had a total attendance of around 25. It seemed the church members were greatly encouraged just by the fact that we tried some kind of evangelism effort. They mentioned wanting to try this again when I return.

We had a potluck meal on the Sunday before I left (last Sunday, June 24) and then a brief sharing session afterwards. One of the things I suggested is that they consider hiring part time the man who had been doing most of the preaching for them. I heard many good comments about his preaching and if he could spend more time visiting visitors and members I think he could really help unify and solidify the church there. So pray that God's will be done in this area. Also, I was able to eat meals with several other members and spend time encouraging them to get involved in any area they can to help their church grow. I will be e-mail and calling many of them to follow up on my efforts to build them
