We had 15 from Grand Junction attend. As you might recall, I have been privileged to preach frequently for the church in Montrose as they have been without a fulltime pulpit man. God has allowed us to help this church as they get through some tough times. Those of you who attended Sunday need to know that your presence was a tremendous encouragement to the church in Montrose and to all the other churches represented there. We can all do mission outreach work.

This morning, Lord willing, I will share how God blessed me and our work with the church on Guam. Thank you so much for your prayers, support of and interest in this mission outreach work. The lessons I gleaned from my three weeks there will also help us here as we attempt to share our faith in Jesus here locally. The text for my lesson/report will be Matthew 9:35-38. Four main points from these four scriptures: **1. Go!** – "Jesus went through all the towns and villages...proclaiming the good news..." Evangelization involves going! **2. Care!** – "he had compassion on them..." We need to have compassion on "harassed and helpless" people around us. **3. Pray!** – "Ask the Lord of the harvest..." **4. Send!** – Not all of us can leave our homes and "go". But we can "Ask the Lord of the harvest,...to send out workers into his harvest field."

We can use our homes for caring and sharing. The elders have asked me to help Bill Wade in organizing and encouraging our "life groups" to be a source of both evangelization and edification. Pray that this effort will help us all in our spiritual growth and outreach to others. More information on this will be forthcoming.
