Discipleship...the missing ingredient

"...if the main job of the god you believe in is to make you feel good about yourself (because you think you are entitled to great self-esteem, along with everything else), then there are **not** a lot of compelling reasons to sit in the dirt at the feet of Jesus and live the humble life of a disciple."...

"After more than a decade and a half of research into American faith, I believe that the Christian church in the United States has a **shallow** faith problem because we have a **discipleship** problem. Moreover diagnosing and treating shallow faith among **young** adults is urgent because we have a shallow faith problem among **all** adults."

The above two quotes are from David Kinnaman's recent book "You Lost Me." The book researches why many 18-29 year olds are leaving institutional churches and some are abandoning faith altogether. These quotes were taken from a chapter entitled "Shallow" as one of the reasons for the exodus. (I highly recommend this book to our church family and leadership.)

If we look into the mirror of God's word (i.e. read our bibles, or come to church and sit on a pew and listen to God's word) then walk away without a renewed, personal commitment to obey and follow Jesus more closely, then we have disengaged ourselves from *discipleship*, we have removed from the equation of faith that critical, necessary ingredient to a sustaining, growing, and meaningful relationship with Jesus.
